In July 2016 we finally achieved a goal that we had been praying about for several years. IBVIE and ETEM completed the process to become one school with a new name – École de théologie évangélique du Québec (ETEQ).


Now our two evangelical church families are mobilized to offer theological training at the university level for the whole church by combining our strengths.
